Dear Mr. Stickle:

Thank you for your letter of November 22, 2005 in which you requested that registrants be allowed to use the notification process set forth under PR Notice 98-10 to add voluntary informational label language concerning certified adjuvants from the Chemical Producers and Distributors Association's certification program.

In his September 27, 2005 letter to you, Jim Jones, Office Director for the Office of Pesticide Programs, stated that the use of wording recommending a specific or certified adjuvant can be done if the labeling language makes it clear that the recommendation is coming from the registrant and not the Agency. The following statement was found to be acceptable and can be added to a pesticide label through the notification process:

"When an adjuvant is to be used with this product, **[name of the registrant of the pesticide]** recommends the use of a Chemical Producers and Distributors Association certified adjuvant"
