Member Categories

Basic Manufacturer:

A "Basic Manufacturer" is a company that produces or has produced an active ingredient and either sells that ingredient under its own label or uses it in the formulation of end-use products into the US agricultural market. Dues range from \$3,608 to \$75,000 per year based on crop and non-crop protection chemical sales¹.

Formulator:

A "Formulator" is a company that formulates or has formulated for end-use products from registered active ingredients. Dues range from \$4,418 to \$59,000 per year based on crop and non-crop protection chemical sales¹.

Distributor:

A "Distributor" is a company that primarily offers products produced by others for sale and provides services into the US agricultural market. Dues range from \$4,418 to \$59,000 per year based on crop and non-crop protection chemical sales¹.

Adjuvants & Inerts Committee (AIC):

An "AIC" member is a company that primarily manufactures and/or sells inert ingredients and/or adjuvants to the crop and non-crop protection industry. Dues range from \$5,552 to \$20,750 per year based on sales into the crop and non-crop protection industry¹.

Associate Member*:

An "Associate Member" is a company that provides non-chemical goods or services to the industry but does not engage in the production or distribution of pesticides, adjuvants or inerts. Dues are \$2,150 per year.

Affiliate Member*:

An "Affiliate Member" is a trade association or organization that shares an allied interest in CPDA's industry related issues. Dues are \$1,260 per year.

Retired Member*:

A "Retired Member" is an individual who is no longer active in the industry. Dues are \$150 per year.
