### GENERAL INFORMATION

Read this entire label before using this product. **PREMIUM** Crop Oil Concentrate is a blend of highly refined phytobland spray oil and a special surfactant system. It is designed for use where the pesticide label recommends the use of a crop oil concentrate adjuvant. **PREMIUM** Crop Oil Concentrate improves wetting and spreading of spray solutions that result in a more uniform coverage of plant and pest surfaces. It also reduces the evaporation loss of spray droplets due to variations in temperature or humidity. **PREMIUM** Crop Oil Concentrate is an oil-based formulation that aids in the penetration of waxy leaf cuticles.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Mixing:** Fill spray tank one-half full and start agitation. Always follow pesticide label directions for proper mixing order, or if no specific mixing order is indicated on the pesticide label use the following sequence:

1. Dry flowables, water dispersable granules
2. Wettable powders
3. Flowables
4. Aqueous solutions
5. Emulsifiable concentrates
6. Add **PREMIUM** Crop Oil Concentrate last and continue agitation

### RECOMMENDED RATES

Ground: 1 - 4 pints in 20 - 50 gallons of spray solution  
Air, CDA, Low Volume: 4 - 8 pints per 100 gallons of spray  
(0.5% - 1.0% v/v concentration)

Do not use less than 0.5% by volume or more than 2.5% by volume. The above recommendations are adequate for most uses. However, some pesticides may require different adjuvant rates. When this occurs, follow the pesticide label directions. Environmental conditions, equipment condition, crop health, pest infestation levels and the accurate operation of spray machinery can influence the effects of the pesticide and the spray application itself. Therefore, it is recommended that adjuvant concentrations be adjusted based on careful observation of spray deposits.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place. Store tightly closed in the original container. Do not use, spill, or store near heat or open flame. Do not add anything else to the container.

**DISPOSAL:** When container is empty, triple rinse the container and pour rinsate into the spray tank. The empty container must be disposed of or recycled according to all local, state and federal laws and regulations. **DO NOT REUSE THE CONTAINER.**
